

IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF THE THIN BLUE LINE – QUIZ



- 1. **Jalla Jalla, Bergsgatan:**
Who eats falafel here? What does falafel contain?
- 2. **The Water Tower, Nobelvägen:**
Which police officer lives on Nobelvägen? What is the local nickname for the Water Tower?
- 3. **The Synagogue, Föreningsgatan:**
Which police officer is of Jewish origin? Who is he/she related to, and in what way?
When the officer comes here, it is for a special reason. Why does he/she go in, and what happens outside after the service?
- 4. **Slottsgatan/Agnesgatan:**
What type of business is being run at this address today? And why do the police go into the premises on the show?
- 5. **Jurek's Grocery Store, Brobygatan:**
Why does Jurek feel threatened and ask for more support from the police?



- 6. **Ribersborg Beach ("Ribban"):**
 - a: When Magnus and Sara are patrolling Ribersborg Beach, Magnus tells Sara what a typical day on the job can look like. But it is also the first time we see that Magnus is falling for Anna. What is Sara eating when Magnus tells her about his bizarre day?

- A bunch of older men have had a bit too much to drink at their Christmas party, and Sara and Faye decide that they need to take one of the men to the station. Before he gets into the police car, he wants to know if Sara has a boyfriend. What happens?
- b: Jesse and Magnus are at Lilla Torg on Saint Lucy's Day. They meet some homeless people, and apart from talking with them, they also do something else. What?



- 17. **Västra Hamnen (Western Harbour):**
When Sara comes back to Malmö after a trip, she doesn't immediately go to see Magnus, but chooses to visit Leah instead. They go out and eat lunch at Bar Italia so that they can talk. What do they talk about, and where is Bar Italia located?
- 18. **Malmö City Library: Kung Oscars väg 11**
Magnus' sister is found with a friend inside the public toilet at Malmö City Library, but what is the name of his sister's character on the show? And which Swedish prime minister lived across from the library for a few years?
- 19. **Pildammsparken:**
Episode 2 begins with Sara and Magnus patrolling near the statue of Galatea (which is visible in the background) in Malmö's largest park. Which park is the largest park in Malmö? And what are people supposed to do by the statue?
- 20. **Finally - do you know:**
 - a: What does the Swedish abbreviation PDV stand for?
 - b: The show's costume designer has made a mistake in the scene when Magnus doesn't let Sara in after they were supposed to have gone on their date. What has she missed?

- b: Kristian, who is mentally ill, has poured petrol over himself, and Sara and Magnus arrive to stop him from setting fire to himself. Curious onlookers film what is going on, and Magnus gets upset with them. Sara manages to stop Kristian, and they take him to the hospital. What buildings can we see in the background from the beach?
- 7. **Drottningtorget:**
Kristian has climbed up onto some scaffolding and is about to jump. He specifically asks after Sara, and she and Magnus arrive before the ambulance. Magnus climbs up and tries to convince Kristian not to jump. How do Magnus and Sara each make their way up to Kristian? And are they able to stop him from jumping?



- 8. **Pilstorp Park opposite Malmö Opera:**
A bus has stopped, and Sara and Magnus have grabbed a young guy with a backpack. They search him and the backpack, as they believe that he is a terrorist. What is inside the backpack, and who is still on the bus while they disarm the young guy?
- 9. **The Bridgehead:**
Two people drive here in a police car. They have turned off the police radio, and they get interrupted by the Chief of Police while they are making out in the car. Who are these two people, and what are they doing the next time we see them at the same location?
- 10. **Möllevångstorget:**
 - a: What happens to Magnus when he and Sara come to the square to take care of a homeless person?
 - b: A robbery takes place in Möllevången, and the robbers have taken someone hostage. They finally

- let him go and flee from the scene. What type of vehicle do the robbers use, and how many of them are there?
- c: Leah lives close to Möllevångstorget. She usually picks up takeaway food from a well-known Malmö restaurant, what is it called?

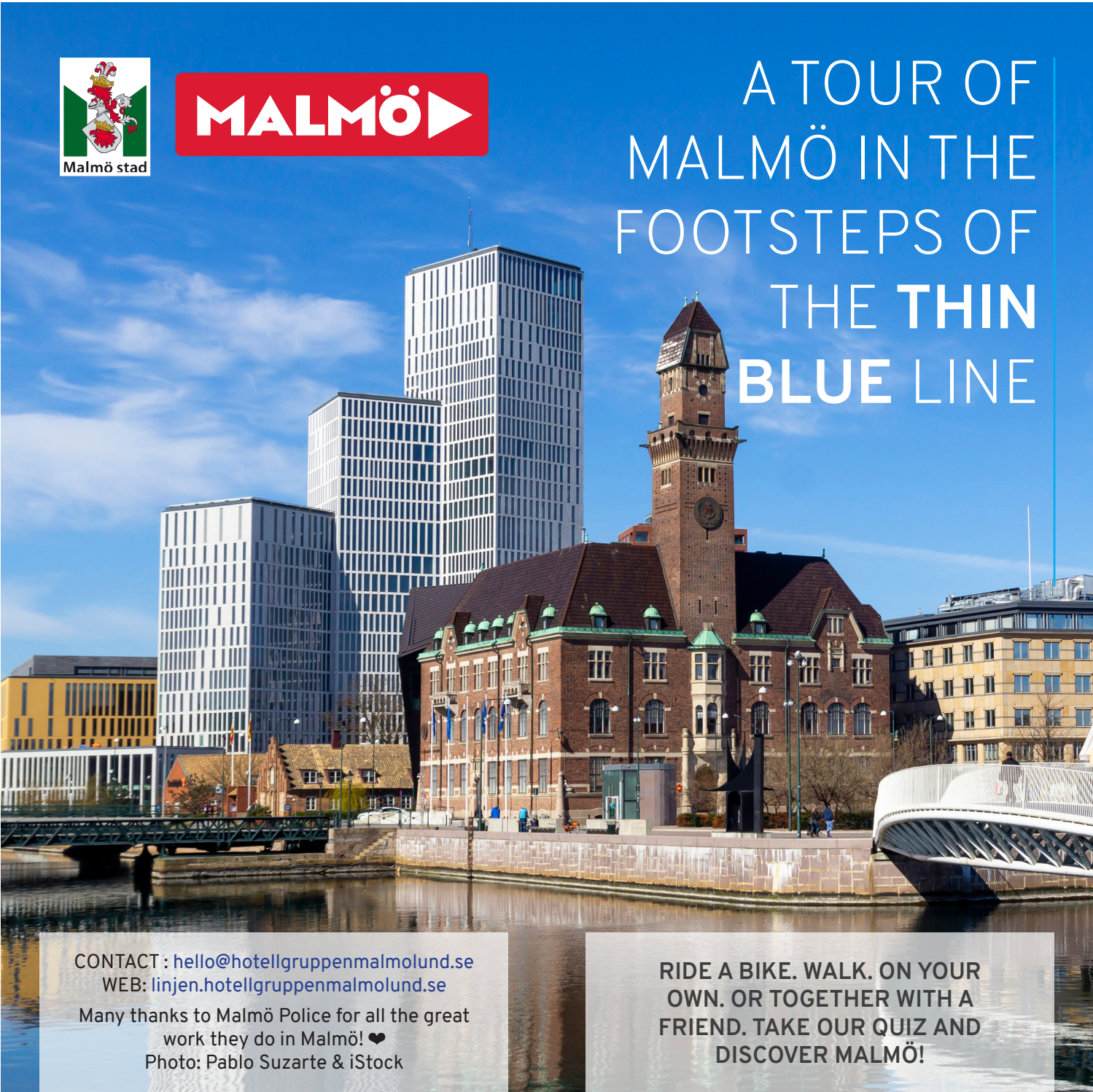
- 11. **The Railway Depot:**
Who do the police chase in here, and how does the chase end?
- 12. **Malmö City Hall:**
The demonstration that passes through the Lugnet district ends up at City Hall. Who is demonstrating, and why?
- 13. **Bullen/Två Krögare, Storgatan 35:**
Who eats a meal here, and what happens when they are about to go home?



- 14. **Plan B/Norra Grängesbergsgatan**
Magnus and Dani come here to have a beer after work. Both are looking for a new relationship, and it turns out they have been checking out the same woman. They hope that she isn't a police officer "because you can't trust them". Just then, a colleague comes over to them. Who is it, and what happens?
- 15. **Story Hotel/Kasai:**
Magnus and Sara are supposed to have their first "real" date here, but Magnus doesn't show up. Why doesn't Magnus show, and what excuse does he give? And what does Sara do?
- 16. **Lilla Torg:**
 - a: Sara and Faye are called out to Lilla Torg to calm things down at one of the restaurants there.

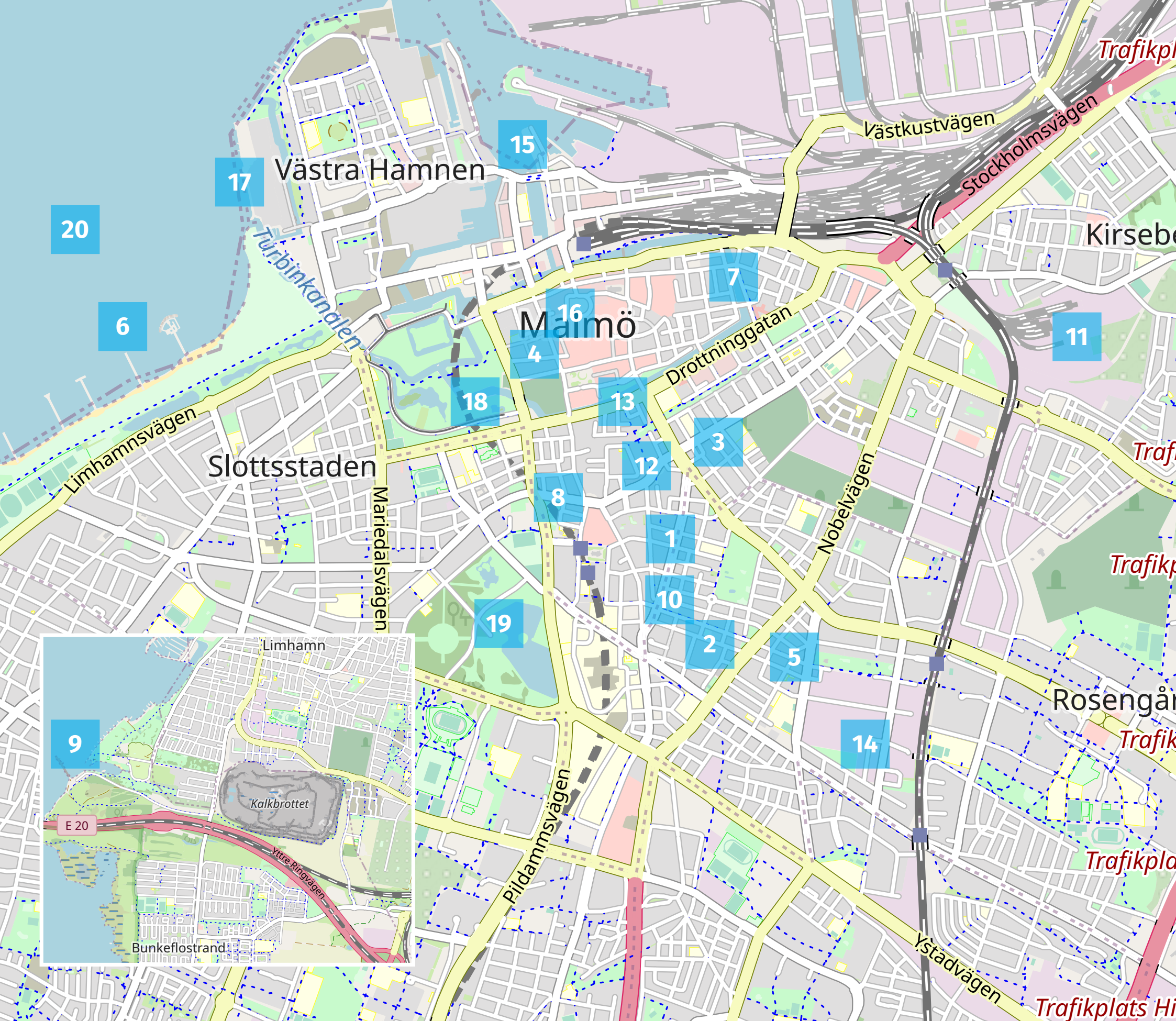

1. Magnus and Sara / Chickpeas
2. Sara / “Kuken” (“The cock”)
3. Leah. She is related to Jurek, who is her grandfather. She goes there when Jurek has died, and afterwards everyone gathers and sings together.
4. There is now a tattoo parlour at this address. On the show they suspect trafficking, as it is a brothel.
5. Young boys deal drugs outside, and they hide their drugs in an old box for newspapers. They are also often inside the store, where they steal things.
6. **a:** A hamburger
b: Turning Torso and Malmö Live
7. Magnus goes up in a construction hoist, and Sara runs up the stairs. No, Kristian jumps.
8. A lunchbox and an apple. His kid brother is still on the bus.
9. Dani and Faye. The next time we see them here they are crying.
10. **a:** A young, attractive girl approaches him and says that she thinks he is good-looking and that she follows him on Instagram, and she gives Magnus her phone number.
b: Mopeds, and there are three of them.
c: Krua Thai
11. The robbers from Möllervången have fled here, and the police capture all three.
12. Neo-Nazis are demonstrating because a 7-year-old girl and her grandfather died in an explosion outside the premises of Project Oskar.
13. Sara and her parents and boyfriend. When they are about to go home, Sara invites her parents to stay with her.
14. The colleague is Sara, who apologises to Magnus and then kisses him. Dani picks up the woman in the bar.
15. He sends a text message and writes that he has stomach ache, when in reality he is depressed that his sister is an addict. Sara goes to Magnus’ home but he doesn’t let her in.
16. **a:** Sara says that she does, and that his name is Magnus. The man says that his name is also Magnus and wants to have sex, but gets told in reply that it won’t be happening.
b: They hand out saffron buns and wish them Merry Christmas.
17. It is the first time Leah talks about the assault in her apartment, and why she is on sick leave after the breakdown in the workshop that was broken into. Bar Italia is located on Scaniaplatsen in Västra Hamnen.
